

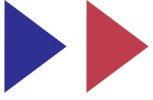

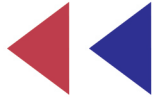

Singapore Education System

The Ministry of Education aims to help students to discover their own talents, to make the best of these talents and realize their full potential, and to develop a passion for learning that lasts through life.

Building on the existing strengths and successes, MOE schools and tertiary institutions prepare the next generation for the future. This is a future that brings tremendous opportunity, especially in Asia, but it will also bring many unforeseeable challenges. Therefore, the task of MOE schools and tertiary institutions is to give the young in Singapore the chance to develop the skills, character and values that will enable them to continue to do well and to take Singapore forward in the future.

In recent years, MOE has forged towards an education system that is more flexible and diverse. The aim is to provide students with greater choice to meet their different interests and ways of learning. Being able to choose what and how they learn will encourage them to take greater ownership of their learning. Giving the students a more broad-based education is the continual goal of the nation. This is to ensure their all-round, holistic development, in and out of the classroom.

Primary Schools

A child in Singapore undergoes six years of primary education, consisting of a four-year foundation stage from Primary 1 to 4 and a two-year orientation stage from Primary 5 to 6. The subjects taught are English as the First Language, Higher Mother Tongue or Mother Tongue as a Secondary Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Art and Craft, Music, Health Education, Physical Education and Character and Citizenship Education. At the end of Primary 6, the students will sit for the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE).

Secondary Schools

Most students in Singapore attend four, five or six years of secondary school education under the Special, Express, Normal or Integrated Programme (IP). After PSLE- the primary school students are streamed into these various levels based on their results. The Special and Express Courses prepare students for the Singapore-Cambridge General Certificate of Education Ordinary' Level Examination (GCE 'O' level) in four years while the Normal stream courses prepare the students to sit for the same exam in 5 years. With this 'O' Level certificate, students can pursue their tertiary/post-secondary education in the local polytechnics or junior colleges, private universities or overseas studies. The six-year Integrated Programme is only available to the top 10% of the PSLE cohort who will sit for the GCE 'A' level exam at the end of their sixth year studies. The IP students need not take GCE 'O' level exam.

Pre-University (Junior College/Centralized Institutes)

Junior colleges and Centralized Institutes prepare students for the Singapore-Cambridge General Certificate of Education Advanced Level Examination (GCE 'A' level) in two years.

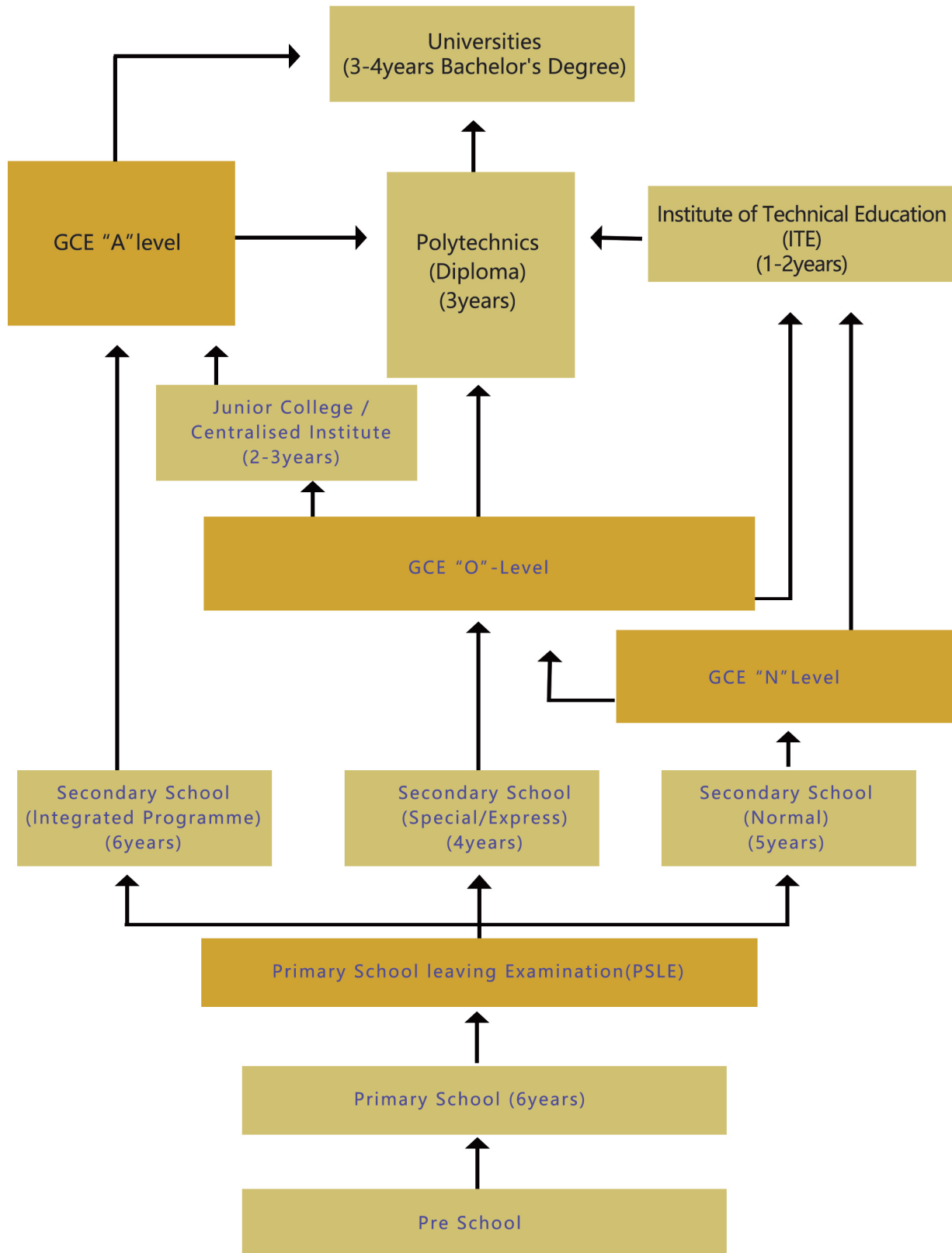
Polytechnics

The five Singapore polytechnics offer a variety of vocational diploma courses such as Banking and Financial Services, Arts, Management, Mass Communications, Engineering, Logistics Management, Design, Nutrition, Health and Wellness, Biomedical Sciences, International Business, and other courses. Each diploma course runs for three years. Foreign students can apply for tuition grants. Polytechnic graduates are valued as practice-oriented and knowledgeable professionals, much sought after by industries.

Institutes of Higher Learning

The seven local universities in Singapore are National University of Singapore (NUS), Nanyang Technological University (NTU), Singapore Management University (SMU), Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD), Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT) and Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS), University of the Arts Singapore(UAS). They have strong affiliations with top overseas universities and provide graduates with internationally recognized degrees. Research and scholarship opportunities are also available to post-graduate students.

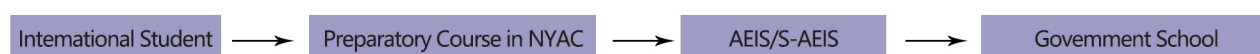


Preparatory Course for Admission to Government Schools (Primary/Secondary)

Introduction

Currently, there are more than 170 primary schools and more than 130 secondary schools in Singapore. New international students who wish to join the main stream primary and secondary schools have to sit for the Admission Exercise for International Students (AEIS) or Supplementary Admission Exercise for International students (S-AEIS) held every September and Feb/Mar respectively.

Our course content is based on the Singapore Ministry of Education (MOE) Primary and Secondary Syllabus for English and Mathematics and the course materials are selected from MOE-approved textbook list. NYAC ensures that our teachers are trained quality educators familiar with the Singapore Education system.

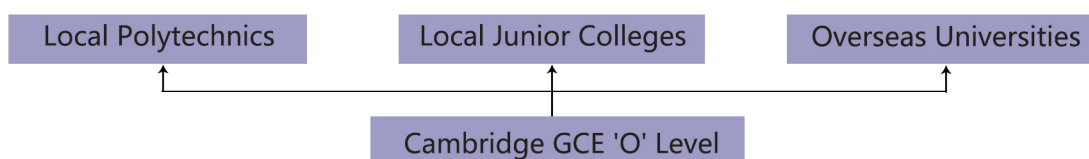

Preparatory Course for Singapore-Cambridge GCE (Ordinary Level) Examination

Introduction

This course prepares students for the Singapore-Cambridge GCE 'O' Level Examination, the same examination taken by the local Secondary 4/5 students (16-17 years old) in Singapore Government schools. The 'O' Level certificate is recognized worldwide. With this qualification, students can continue to pursue post-secondary education in local polytechnics or junior colleges in Singapore. They can also choose to pursue their studies in the Commonwealth countries and the United States of America.

Our subject content is based on the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board Syllabi for the offered subjects and reviewed regularly to ensure consistency. NYAC ensures that our teachers are trained quality educators familiar with the 'O' Level Examinations to help bring our students to their fullest potential.

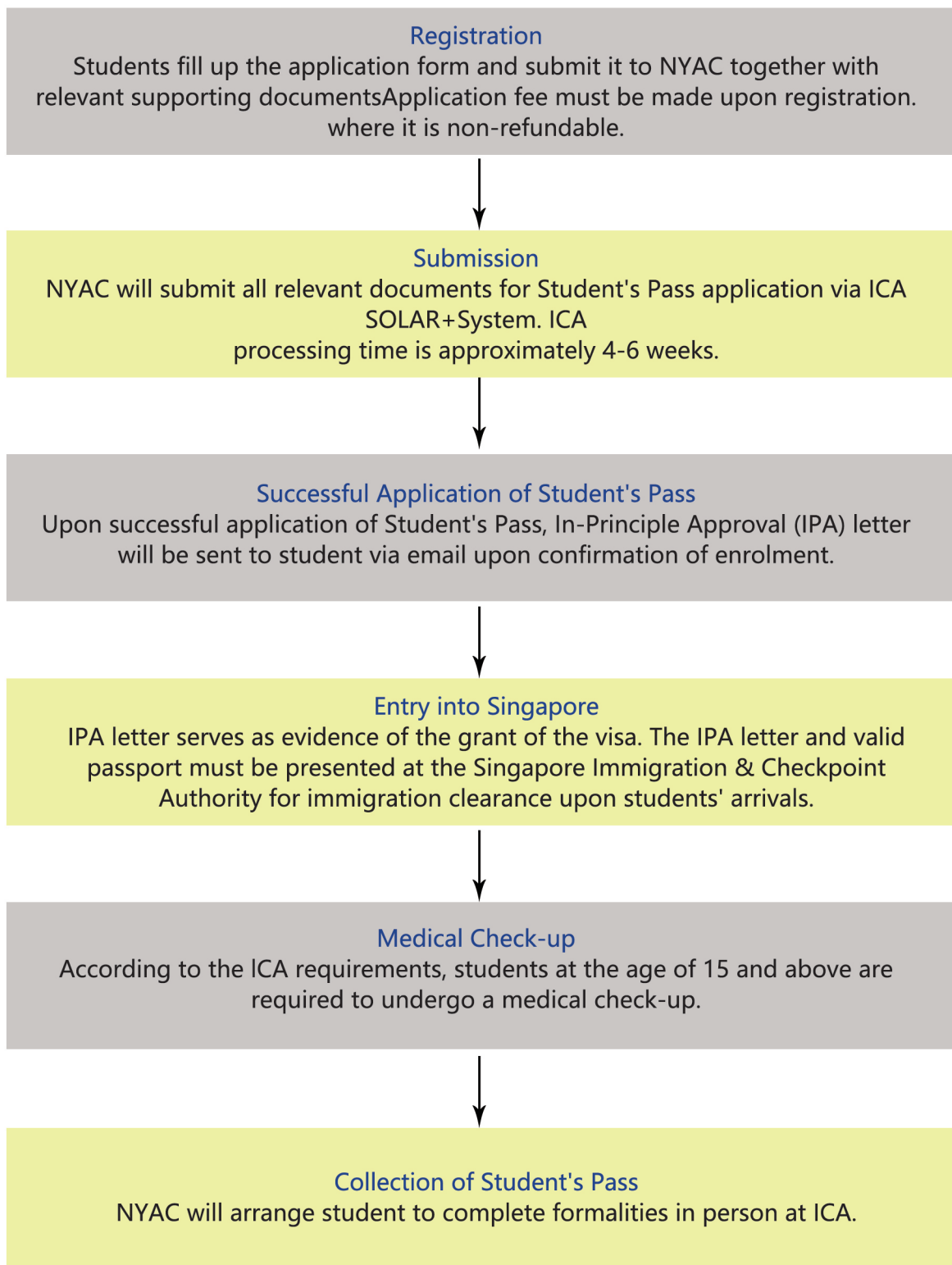

● Singapore's Food & Accommodation

Singapore's living conditions are fairly superior. Our college is very near to the Jurong East MRT station. Dwelling accommodation is available close to the college and there is no necessity to commute by public transport as you can reach our college by foot. You have a choice of 3 types of accommodation :

First class : Stay in condominium to accommodate 2 people in a room complete with sports facilities, BBQ, swimming pool, tennis court etc. Hygiene and sanitation and clothes washing services are available , complete with daily breakfast and dinner.

Second class : Stay in HDB apartment to accommodate 2 people in a room complete with hygiene and sanitation and clothes washing services plus daily breakfast and dinner. Accessible to exercise parks and jogging tracks.

Third class : Stay in HDB apartment to accommodate 2 people in a room with accessibility to exercise parks and jogging tracks. There will be no hygiene and sanitation and clothes washing services in your apartment and meals are at your own personal expense.

Regardless of the above 3 types of accommodation, all students will be provided twice weekly class lessons on English and Mathematics with close supervision by teachers to ensure that class lessons are well understood, assignments are completed and students' queries are properly and adequately handled by the teachers.

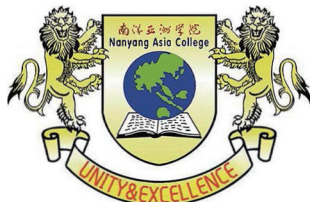
Choice of first and second class accommodation will include both breakfast and dinner and lunch will be on your own personal expense. What will be the typical menu for both your breakfast and dinner ?
